Leaving the City in 1964, Roger entered the world of Entertainment. His West End appearances in the sixties & seventies included 'Sweet Charity as well as 'Two Cities & Company'. Moving into the world of Comedy and Ventriloquism he appeared in venues ranging from Las Vegas with Dean Martin to the Royal Variety Performance in front of Her Majesty The Queen Mother. He also made numerous television appearances in the seventies and eighties. He now runs his own Management Company looking after a number of top artists and performers.

Roger is Vice President of the Royal Variety Charity, a Past King Rat of the show business charity The Grand Order of Water Rats and a keen golfer having been Captain of the Varsity Club of Great Britain Golf Society. He is also a member of the Oriental Club.

Roger Joined the Glovers in 1995, was elected to the Court in 2010 and amongst other responsibilities has been chairman of the Charity Projects Committee.
